I was born in Atchison, Kansas. I became one of the most iconic and admired figures in aviation history. My life was marked by an indomitable passion for the skies, achieving feats that still endure in the collective memory today. I was also an advocate for gender equality and the inclusion of women in aeronautics, a male-dominated field.

WORK EXPERIENCE

● Passenger at the Atlantic crossing 1928

First women to make the Atlantic crossing as a passenger. In a plane commanded by pilots Wilmer Stultz and Louis Gordon, which traveled the 3,200 kilometers between Newfoundland and Wales.

● Made the Atlantic crossing alone 1932

Setting a speed record of 30 hours and 50 minutes to reach Ireland. I was the first woman awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross by the U.S Congress for that.

● Crossing the Pacific between Hawaii and California 1935

I broke the record for non-stop flight over the Pacific.

● Around world voyage 1937

Following the equator in a twin-engine Lockheed Electra 10-E flying from Miami (Florida) to South America, from there to Africa and later to the East Indies
