• Professional Painter and Visual Artist

Europe | Early 1900s – 1944

I developed and exhibited my artwork across Europe, becoming a pioneer of abstract art and exploring the emotional power of color and form.

• Art Professor – Bauhaus School

Germany | 1922 – 1933

I taught courses on color theory, form, and composition, influencing modern art education and future generations of artists.

• Art Theorist and Writer

I wrote important theoretical texts, including Concerning the Spiritual in Art, where I explained my artistic philosophy and ideas on abstraction.

• Co-founder of Art Movements (Der Blaue Reiter)

I helped establish avant-garde art groups that promoted innovation and new artistic expression.

I studied law and economics and later worked as a university lecturer before deciding to pursue art.

Munich, Germany | From 1896
